**Dr. William Cheung**

Institute for the Oceans and Fisheries, UBC (Canada)

Dr. William Cheung is a Professor at the Institute for the Oceans and Fisheries, University of British Columbia (UBC, Canada) and the Scientific Director of the Nippon Foundation-UBC Nereus Program. He holds a Ph.D. in Resource Management and Environmental Studies at UBC, and from 2009 to 2011, William was a Lecturer in Marine Ecosystem Services at the School of Environmental Sciences, University of East Anglia (UK). His outstanding research career has focused on understanding the responses and vulnerabilities of marine ecosystems and fisheries to global change, and examining trade-offs in managing and conserving living marine resources. His research cuts across multiple disciplines, from oceanography to ecology, economics and social sciences. His ecological climate models are key to current international reports, and he has been a Coordinating Lead Author on the IPCC SROCC, and Lead Author in the IPCC 5th Assessment Report, a Coordinating Lead Author of the IPBES and Global Biodiversity Outlook. Dr. Cheung has received numerous prizes and he has published more than 150 articles in SCI journals.
